5 Highlights From Art Basel 2024

The Statements sector, dedicated to solo presentations by emerging artists, was particularly strong this year. Highlights include <u>Sandra Poulson's</u> fabric sculptures acknowledging the ubiquity of AK-47s in everyday Angolan life at Jahmek Contemporary Art; <u>Teresa Baker's</u> AstroTurf wall hangings incorporating not only yarn but also natural materials like buckskin at Broadway Gallery; <u>Flo Brooks's</u> acrylic paintings appliquéd on found fabric that explore trans and gender-

nonconforming histories at Project Native Informant; <u>Juliette</u>

<u>Minchin's</u> sculptures at Galerie Anne-Sarah Bénichou, in which wax appeared draped like sheer, delicate fabric over brass apparatuses; and

<u>Francisco Rodríguez's</u> 16-meter panoramic painting, inspired by Bruegel and Chinese scrolls, of teenage boys carousing across a Chilean school campus at White Space.
