Paris Photo 2022 Exhibitors

The 25th edition of Photo Paris will have 183 exhibitors across all sectors, of which 48 are new ones. The Grand Palais Ephémère will have 180 stands with 24 solo shows, 14 duo shows, and 92 group shows. The selection includes 1613 artists, of which 31% make women artists.

Most exhibitors come from Europe (70%), followed by North America 17%, Asia and Oceania 7%, Africa and the Middle East 4%, and South America 2%.

Photographers who will have **solo shows** include Daniel Gordon, presenting a unique installation at the **Huxley Parlour** gallery from London; Barbara Probst, with a triptych realized during the confinement and her work in 12 parts *Exposure #106* at **Kuckei** + **Kuckei** (Berlin); and Boris Mikhaïlov at **Suzanne Tarasieve** (Paris) with an homage to the Ukrainian people in a rarely shown series, *Theater of War*.

The roster of **duo shows** includes a joint presentation by Léonard Bourgeois Baulieu and Laurent Montaron at the **Anne-Sarah Benichou** gallery (Paris), Julio Bittencourt and Mame-Diarra Niang at **Lume** (São Paulo), and Anna Fabricius and Dafna Talmor at **Tobe** (Budapest).
